

## NUIST Diary

### **Day 1 and 2 (25-26/03/24)**

On Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March, we left campus on the 21 bus to the Reading train station so we can get the Rail air coach to Heathrow T2 airport to catch our CA-938 the 8:25pm flight, we got there at 5:30pm ish and boarded around 7:55pm for our 10 hour flight but we managed to get in Beijing in 9 hours then we wait until we boarded our next plane around 16:00pm on Wednesday for our CA- 1503 flight to Nanjing. When we arrived the Nanjing airport around 9pm and took a taxi to the Nanqi Hotel around 10pm.



### **Day 3 (27/03/24)**

We woke up early for our start today, we had breakfast at 8am until 9:30pm, so we can collect our campus card and visited the Reading Academy and the professor in charge. We had lunch at 11:30am on the second floor of the EastCanteen and ordered “Fragrant chicken” which was a little spicy. We were pleasantly surprised with the amount of choice of food available. Class ends at 11:50am in NUIST so we are lucky to avoid the afternoon rush. Then right after we visited the supermarket on campus to see what snacks we could buy. There were so many snacks available. #### **Day 4 (28/03/24)**
