Reception

Reception is on the ground floor of Windsor Hall.

Post

Postboxes are on the outside wall of Park Lounge.
Collect parcels and registered mail from Park Reception
between 08:30–09:30 and 14:00–18:30.

Lift access

No, rooms arranged over four floors.

Social facilities

Park Lounge room contains a TV screen and pool table.
Located opposite Park Eat. Allocated study space
is Park Lounge.

Special requirements

No Quiet Lifestyle or single-sex areas available in this hall.

Meal Plan?

The University recommends all first year students enrol onto a Meal Plan. If you haven't already, you can enrol onto a fixed price Meal Plan, ranging from 3 to 21 meals per week, by visiting www.reading.ac.uk/clevercuisine. The closest catering outlet is Park Eat.

Your kitchen

Each Kitchen is equipped with a fridge/freezer, kettles, toasters, microwave, hobs and oven and is shared between six and nine residents. Each resident has one fridge and freezer shelf and two cupboards.

Do I need induction pans?

No. Greenow House has standard electric ovens and hobs. You do not need a particular type of pan. If purchasing a kitchen pack, please select 'standard hob kitchen pack'.

Bed size

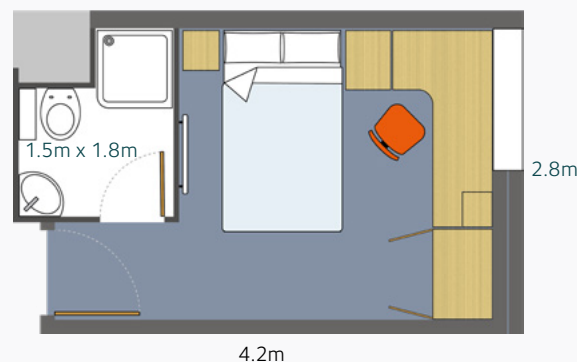
- En-suite: single bed, 3'0"x6'3" (91.5cm x 190.5cm)

Each room contains bed, desk, curtains, chair, shelves, wardrobe and rubbish bin.

Bedding packs and mattress toppers are available to purchase online or from your local reception.

En-suite bathrooms have a toilet, sink, washbasin and shower with curtain in a 'wet room' style and a fixed showerhead.
