Reception

Reception can be found at St George's Hall.

Post

Postboxes are inside Oakhurst Block. Collect parcels and registered mail from St Georges Reception between 08:30–09:30 and 14:00–18:30.

Lift access

Yes: Rowanhurst, Limehurst and Oakhurst.
No: Elmhurst House and Elmhurst Wing.

Social facilities

St. George's common room contains a TV screen, ample seating and pool table. Allocated study space is Study Space in Oakhurst and JCR in Elmhurst Wing.

Special requirements

Quieter Lifestyle areas available in this hall.

Meal Plan?

The University recommends all first year students enrol onto a Meal Plan. If you haven't already, you can enrol onto a fixed price Meal Plan, ranging from 3 to 21 meals per week, by visiting www.reading.ac.uk/clevercuisine. The closest catering outlet is Park Eat.

Your kitchen

Each Kitchen is equipped with a kettle, toaster, ovens and hobs and is shared between six to twelve residents. Each resident has one kitchen cupboard, and one fridge and freezer shelf.

Do I need induction pans?

No. St George's Hall has standard electric ovens and hobs. You do not need a particular type of pan. If purchasing a kitchen pack, please select 'standard hob kitchen pack'.

Bed size


- Upgraded room with washbasin and shared bathroom facilities: small double, 4'0"x6'3" (122cm x 190.5cm)
double – single occupancy, 4'6"x6'3" (137cm x 190.5cm)

Each room contains bed, desk, chair, shelves, wardrobe, curtains and rubbish bins. There is also storage under the bed.

Bedding packs and mattress toppers are available to purchase online or from your local reception.

Shared bathrooms are unisex and consist of separate showers/WCs and are cleaned on a regular basis. Toilet paper is provided. Approximately five residents share a bathroom.
