Reception

Reception can be found at Sherfield Hall.

Post

Postboxes are located in the Sherfield JCR next to Reception. Collect parcels and registered mail from Reception between 08:30–09:30 and 14:00–18:30.

Lift access

No lift. Rooms arranged over three floors.

Social facilities

St Patrick's Common Room is spacious and contains a TV screen and piano. Allocated study space is St Pat's Study Space and St Pat's JCR.

Special requirements

Due to the corridor layout of St Patrick's Hall, we are not able to cater to special requirements.

Meal Plan?

Each kitchenette is shared between eight and sixteen residents. Kitchenettes have a small fridge/freezer, kettle, toaster, microwave, hob and oven. As this is a Meal Plan hall, please be mindful of limited storage space in kitchenettes.

As part of the Gold Meal plan, you get 14 Meal Swipes per week during term time. You can check your balance/plan by downloading the CBord GET app or going to get.cbord.com, selecting University of Reading and signing in using your University username/password.

Catering outlets

Do I need induction pans?

3'0" x 6'3" (91.5cm x 190.5cm)


Each room contains bed, desk, chair, shelves, wardrobe and rubbish bins. There is also storage under the bed.
