Reception

Reception can be found at St George's Hall.

Post

Postboxes are inside the entrance to Wantage Hall.

Collect parcels and registered mail from St Georges Reception between 08:30–09:30 and 14:00–18:30.

Lift access

Wantage common room and TV room. Allocated study space is Wantage Study Space and Wantage JCR.

Meal Plan?

Wantage Hall is a Meal Plan Hall. Each kitchenette is shared between five and twenty four residents. Kitchenettes have a fridge/freezer, kettles, toasters, microwave, oven and hob. As this is a Meal Plan hall, please be mindful of limited storage space in kitchenettes. As part of the Platinum Meal plan, you get 21 Meal Swipes per week during term time. You can check your balance/plan by downloading the CBord GET app or going to get.cbord.com, selecting University of Reading and signing in using your University username/password.

Allcroft Road: 2 minutes


Bus: Leopard (3 or 10) and 9

Bed size


- Standard/upgraded room with/without washbasin: single bed, 3'0" x 6'3" (91.5cm x 190.5cm)
- Standard room with/without washbasin: double bed, 4'0" x 6'3" (122cm x 190.5cm)

Each room contains bed, desk, chair, shelves, wardrobe, curtains and rubbish bins. There is also storage under the bed. **Shared bathrooms** are unisex. Bedding packs and mattress toppers are available to purchase online or from your local reception.
