





Year-long contracts

51-week contracts, running from September to September, are available in most University accommodation.

Postgraduate students often select this option but it is also suitable for undergraduates who would like to use their room over the Summer vacation.

WHAT ARE YOUR OPTIONS?

CREIGHTON COURT

Suitable for families with children

Creighton Court is located within a 15-minute walk from central campus and includes 24 purpose-built self contained flats suitable for families with one or two children under 12 years of age.

There is a self-contained garden for the exclusive use of Creighton Court residents. There is a laundry on-site and a lockable bike shed. All flats offer showers over baths.

Availability: 24 rooms

BENYON HALL FARMHOUSE

Suitable for couples and mature students

The Benyon Farmhouse is situated within the grounds of Benyon Hall. This 19th-century historic listed building offers a range of accommodation and includes a shared garden to the rear.

The Farmhouse is within a 15-minutes' walk from the centre of campus and is close to local shops and bus stop into central Reading and the station.

Availability: 7 rooms

NORTHCOURT AVENUE HOUSES

Suitable for couples and mature students

There are three separate houses located on Northcourt Avenue which offer a range of options for couples and mature students.

Northcourt Avenue is within a 15-minute walk from the Whiteknights cam pus centre and is less than a 5-minute walk from shops, cafes and a bus stop serving Reading town centre and the train station.

12 Northcourt Avenue

Large detached property spread over three floors with at least one bathroom per floor. Three kitchens, one on each floor, are shared by all of the residents. Rooms include a washbasin and bathroom facilities are shared with other residents.

Availability: 14 rooms

14 Northcourt Avenue

This large detached house offers a range of rooms with their own individual style and character. The bathroom facilities are available on each floor and are shared between residents along with the kitchen. Some of the rooms include their own washbasin.

Availability: 9 rooms

16 Northcourt Avenue

This large detached house offers a selection of self-contained flats and studios, as well as en-suite rooms with a shared kitchen. This traditional character property also benefits from a small enclosed garden.

Availability: 12 rooms

SHERFIELD HALL FLATS

Suitable for couples and mature students

At the top of the Sherfield Hall accommodation blocks we have several one-bedroom flats suitable for couples and mature students. A short walk from the centre of campus and conveniently located for local shops and transport to Reading town centre and station.

Availability: 5 rooms

ST GEORGE'S, WESSEX AND WANTAGE HALL FLATS/STUDIOS

Suitable for couples and mature students

St George's, Wessex and Wantage Halls offer a selection of self contained studios and flats. The pedestrian entrance to the rear of St George's Hall is located directly opposite the University Sports Park, offering easy access to campus.

Availability: 33 rooms, made up from

- · Wessex: 1 studio
- St Georges: 6 one-bed flats, 25 Studios
- · Wantage: 1 one-bed flat

ST PATRICK'S HALL FLATS/SETS

Suitable for couples and mature students

St Patrick's Hall is within a 15-minute walk from the campus centre and conveniently located for local shops, eating places and buses to Reading town centre and station.

Availability: 7 (1 two-bed flat, 4 study sets, 2 couple rooms)

GREENOW FLAT

Suitable for couples and mature students

Located on the ground floor of Greenow House which is just a few minutes walk from Park Group social hub and the centre of campus. This is a two-bedroom flat suitable for two mature students or a couple.

Availability: 1 two-bed flat
