#### Hall address

Your name, flat, house Windsor Hall Shinfield Road Reading, RG6 6HW

Greenow House is part of Windsor Hall within Park Group.

#### Reception

Reception is on the ground floor of Windsor Hall.

#### **Post**

Postboxes are on the outside wall of Park Lounge. Collect parcels and registered mail from Park Reception between 08:30–09:30 and 14:00–18:30.

#### Lift access

No, rooms arranged over four floors.

#### Social facilities

Park Lounge room contains a TV screen and pool table. Located opposite Park Eat. Allocated study space is Park Lounge.

#### **Special requirements**

No Quiet Lifestyle or single-sex areas available in this hall.

#### Meal Plan?

The University recommends all first year students enrol onto a Meal Plan. If you haven't already, you can enrol onto a fixed price Meal Plan, ranging from 3 to 21 meals per week, by visiting www.clever-cuisine.com. The closest catering outlet is Park Eat.

#### Your kitchen
