#### **Reception**

Reception can be found at Sherfield Hall.

#### **Post**

Postboxes are at the Sherfield Reception. Collect parcels and registered mail from Reception between 08:30–09:30 and 14:00–18:30.

#### Lift access

No lift. Rooms arranged over three floors.

#### **Social facilities**

St Patrick's Common Room is spacious and contains a TV screen and piano. Allocated study space is St Pat's Study Space and St Pat's JCR.

#### **Special requirements**

Due to the corridor layout of St Patrick's Hall, we are not able to cater to special requirements.

#### **Meal Plan?**

#### **Bed size**


 Standard room with/without washbasin: 3'0"x6'3" (91.5cmx190.5cm)
