FACILITIES

Your room

We do not provide a cleaning service for bedrooms, so please keep your room clean and tidy during your stay and upon departure. A vacuum cleaner is kept in your communal area.

Your kitchen

Kitchens are cleaned once a week and rubbish is cleared twice per week. Please be aware that communal areas are shared with other residents and that flats may be at full occupancy throughout summer, so please respect others by clearing up after using the facilities.

We ask that you use the recycling facilities provided and take empty bottles to the site bottle bank. Please remove all items in the shared fridge freezer upon departure.

Laundry

All guests have access to our 24 hour laundry facilities. If you wish to use the laundry, please ask for a card at reception, which you can top-up to use the facilities and return at the end of your stay. There is signage to direct you to the laundry, or ask at reception for directions.

Safety and maintenance

All utilities are included in the room price. If you experience any maintenance issues, please report them immediately to the 24 hour on-site Halls Hotline.

Please familiarise yourself with our fire safety procedures which are in every bedroom.

Pay particular attention to:

- your nearest escape route
- fire assembly point
- fire alarm call points

Fire alarm testing takes place throughout the week. There's no need to vacate the building during testing, but if the alarm continues for a longer period, please follow the fire safety procedures.

Smoking is not allowed inside or within 10 metres of any building.



On-campus amenities and the local area

All halls are within walking distance to convenience stores, takeaway restaurants and pharmacies. There is a Co-Op on campus. Please ask at reception for specific details.
